- 2. MAXIMUM NUMBER OF CANDIDATES TO BE ADMITTED 2019-2020: 15 (Fifteen).

PLEASE NOTE THAT the Ph.D. Programme is unlike all other programmes of study because there is no fixed number of seats to be filled. The number of candidates admitted depends on their suitability and preparedness for research at this level, the availability of faculty members interested in the proposed research area who also have vacant slots, and so on. None of the eligibility conditions (including, for example, a JRF fellowship, etc.) can in themselves guarantee admission. (The number of seats announced is a theoretical maximum; the actual number considered for admission is likely to be much less.)

3. Selected candidates will be required to attend course work towards the PhD. The timetable will be posted on the Department website and the Notice Board in the Department of Sociology.
