FROM REJECTING PATERNALISM TO TRANSGRESSING GENDER: Some thoughts on gender and sport

Abstract:

Drawing on personal narratives but locating them within a feminist understanding of sports, this presentation will cover the experience of the labours of care that young sports persons experience as they move from school to the university. In retrospect, this experience also views sports, in this case track and field athletics, as both a space of transgression and liberation.

The Speaker:

Meena Gopal is currently the Chairperson of the Advanced Centre for Women's Studies at the Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai. Her research interests include gender and labour; the political economy of health, welfare and development; sexuality studies; and social movements. Her most recent book is the co-edited volume *Women in the Worlds of Labour: Interdisciplinary and Intersectional Perspectives* (Orient BlackSwan, 2021). She is active in the autonomous feminist collective, Forum Against Oppression of Women, Bombay. From 1981 to 1988, she trained and competed in state, university and national track and field athletics.
