

M.A. First Semester Internal Assessment 2023

1. The Internal Assessment for M.A. First Semester will commence from Monday, 18th September 2023 with a span period of 12 weeks i.e. from **18/09/2023 to 08/12/2023.**
2. M.A. Semester I will follow a module of *three weeks* for each subject tutorials which means two weeks of tutorial meetings plus one week time for the students to submit their assignment before moving to another slab with another Tutor.
3. For the purpose of Internal Assessment Program, the semester is divided into **FOUR TIME SLABS of three weeks** each:
 - (i) **SLAB 1: 18/09/2023 to 06/10/2023**
First Week Class to be held between: 18th Sept to 22nd September 2023
Second Week Class: 25th Sept to 29th Sept 2023
Third Week: Assignment Submission latest by **6th October 2023.**
 - (ii) **SLAB 2: 09/10/2023 to 27/10/2023**
First Week Class to be held between: 9th October to 13th October 2023
Second Week Class: 16th October to 20th October 2023
Third Week: Assignment Submission latest by **27th October 2023.**
 - (iii) **SLAB 3: 30/10/2023 to 17/11/2023**
First Week Class to be held between: 30th October to 3rd November 2023
Second Week Class: 6th November to 10th November 2023
Third Week: Assignment Submission latest by **17th November 2023.**
 - (iv) **SLAB 4: 20/11/2023 to 08/12/2023**
First Week Class to be held between: 20th November to 24th November 2023
Second Week Class: 27th November to 1st December 2023
Third Week: Assignment Submission latest by **8th December 2023.**

In each time slab, a student will be attending and working on the assignment for one particular course for one particular teacher. This will involve attending the tutorial meetings held for the course, carrying out the assigned reading and writing work and submitting the assignment as prescribed by the course teacher. Thereafter, they will move to the next course teacher as assigned.

Attendance in the tutorial meetings is compulsory and no student will be allowed to submit the assignment if they have not attended the tutorial meetings. There will be a

minimum of two meetings per course. **THE DEPARTMENT HAS A POLICY F ZERO TOLERANCE TOWARDS PLAGIARISM.**

Students are required to meet the course teacher of the Slab 1 course immediately. For any further clarification and inadvertent omission of any student from the list, please contact the Tutorial Committee of the department immediately.
