SUBMISSION OF ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS FOR VERIFICATION

All students admitted to M.A. Programme in Sociology in the 2020-21 academic session must submit their original documents (paper certificates etc.) in the Department Office for verification latest by 28th February, 2022. As per University rules, students who fail to do so may have their admission cancelled without further notice.

Please submit the same certificates on the basis of which you were given admission in the Department. Please bring the originals, along with two self-attested copies of each of the documents; the originals will be returned to you after verification.

Here is a provisional list of the documents you are required to produce (it is the same list that was issued at the time of your admission in 2020).

1. Class X Certificate (Marks sheet or certificate) indicating date of birth and Parents' names* (The names of applicants claiming reservation under OBC/EWS/ SC/ST/CW/ PwD must match with the names that appear on the corresponding reservation certificates; similarly, their parents' names must match in both sets of certificates).
2. Class XII Marks Sheet.
3. Four passport size photographs.
4. Consolidated marks sheet and Degree Certificate of qualifying examination on the basis of which the candidate is seeking admission.
5. OBC/EWS/ SC/ST /CW/ PwD Certificate (in the name of the Applicant) issued by the competent authority (where relevant).
6. OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) Certificate (in the name of the Applicant) issued after March 31, 2019 by the competent authority, and wherein the caste is in the OBC central list issued by <http://ncbc.nic.in>. (where relevant)
7. EWS Certificate from competent authority certifying that the applicant can claim reservation under this category (where relevant).
8. One identity proof issued by the Competent Authority as notified by Government of India. (For example: Aadhaar, PAN card, Voter ID, Passport, etc.)

Please ensure that you meet the deadline in order to avoid unnecessary complications.
