Note:

- 1. The UGC mandated 2 credit RPE course is compulsory for all PhD students.
- 2. The Research Methods course (4 credits) is compulsory for all students who require coursework. Students who are not taking this course must ensure they have the requisite equivalence certificate as per the Ordinance.
- 3. All courses (except the RPE) are for 4 credits. One additional hour of individual consultation apart from 3 hours in the timetable above will be intimated by the course teacher. Each course will meet for 12-14 weeks within the coursework period.
- 4. Apart from the courses shown in this timetable, students may also have the option of doing a Supervised Readings Course with their supervisor. This course will have the same requirements for meetings, attendance and grading as any other optional course.
- 5. Each student completing coursework must register two optional courses (one of which may be the Supervised Reading Course) before 10 am on Friday 3 March, 2023.
