

The Political Ecology of Charismatic Carnivore Conservation

ABSTRACT

In this talk, I will draw on my 25-year long association with the forests of Kuno in central India, to discuss the actors, institutions and ideas that have (re)shaped this landscape. I'll highlight some structural elements of India's regimes of conservation, and show how they collide with historical and contemporary local realities in conjunctural and complicated ways. What does this mean for the humans and non-humans who share this landscape, and what does it mean for us, India's conservation-minded elite?
